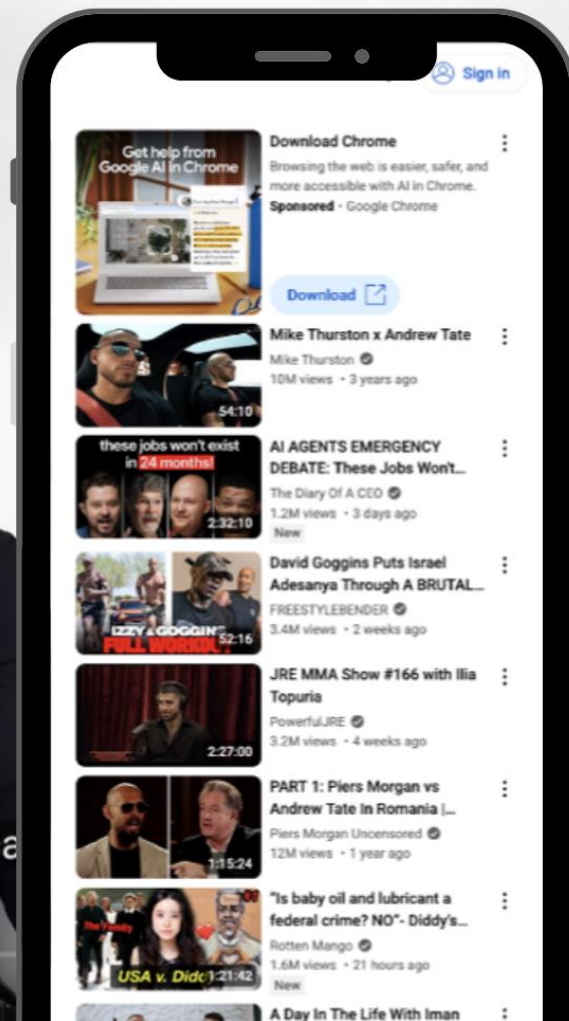
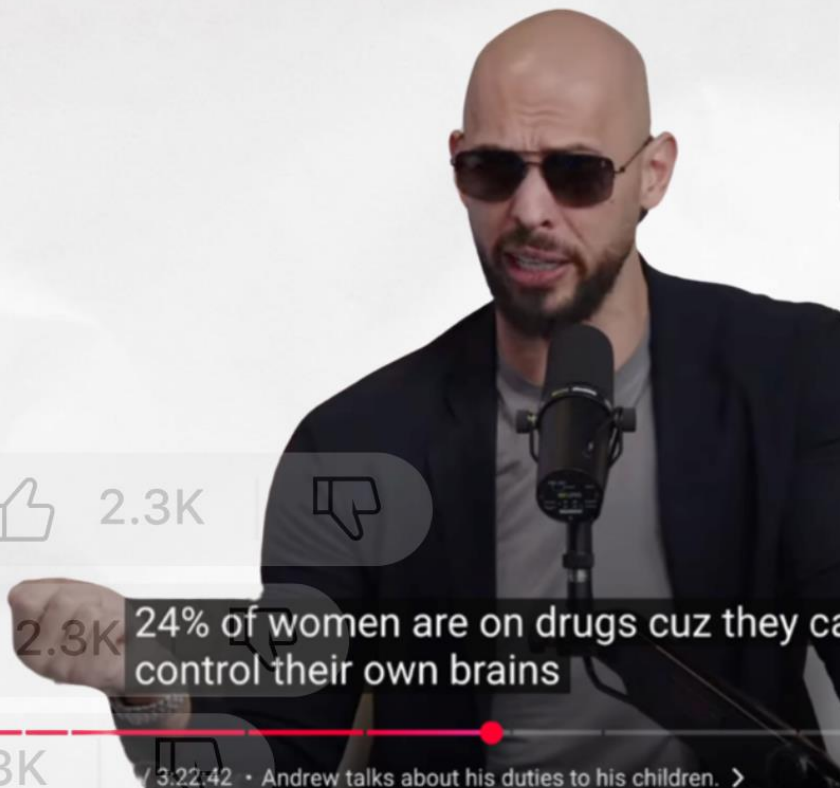


BANNED BUT NOT GONE

How YouTube bans Andrew Tate,
then profits from his misogyny anyway



YouTube still profiting from misogynist Andrew Tate content with millions of views

New research has found that misogynist videos featuring Andrew Tate are still amassing millions of views on YouTube, where videos often feature profit-generating ads and are easily accessible to boys as young as 13.

Despite YouTube's ban on Tate, researchers found that his influence on the platform continues to be propelled by guest appearances on podcasts and videos made by fans.ⁱ

The Center for Countering Digital Hate identified 100 of the most-viewed YouTube videos of Tate promoting misogyny posted over the last year, with nearly 54 million views in total.ⁱⁱ Of this list of 100 videos, researchers found that:

- All 100 videos can be viewed by boys aged 13 in the UK and the US
- 98 out of 100 were proven to be accessible to boys aged 13 in Ireland and Germany
- 97 out of 100 videos have auto-translated captions into multiple languages
- 65 out of 100 videos were made and posted by Tate 'fan accounts'
- 58 out of 100 violate YouTube's policies on hate speech
- 31 out of 100 videos violating YouTube's policies carry ads from big brands

Andrew Tate is a social media influencer known for promoting misogyny and violence against women.ⁱⁱⁱ The former kickboxer rose to notoriety in 2016 when he was removed from a British reality show after a video was released of him hitting a woman with a belt.^{iv}

Tate quickly developed a large following on TikTok in 2022, amassing billions of views from promoting extreme statements, including comparisons of women to property.^v In response to his promotion of hate and violence against women, YouTube, alongside TikTok and Meta, "terminated channels associated with Andrew Tate" in 2022.^{vi}

However, thanks to subscribers of his online course "The Real World", Tate has retained his presence on the platform through fan-made content. Moreover, a recent article revealed that YouTube has stripped back on content moderation following Trump's return, encouraging its moderators to leave videos with content breaching platform policies up.^{vii}

Along with his brother Tristan, Tate is due to return to the UK to face 21 criminal charges, including rape and human trafficking.^{viii} In on YouTube video identified in the course of this research Tate responds to the allegations by accusing his victims of lying, claiming: *"If they can get one silly b***** to lie, now you're fucked. It's crazy because 27% of women are on anti-depressants. So, they're basically clinically nuts."*^{ix}

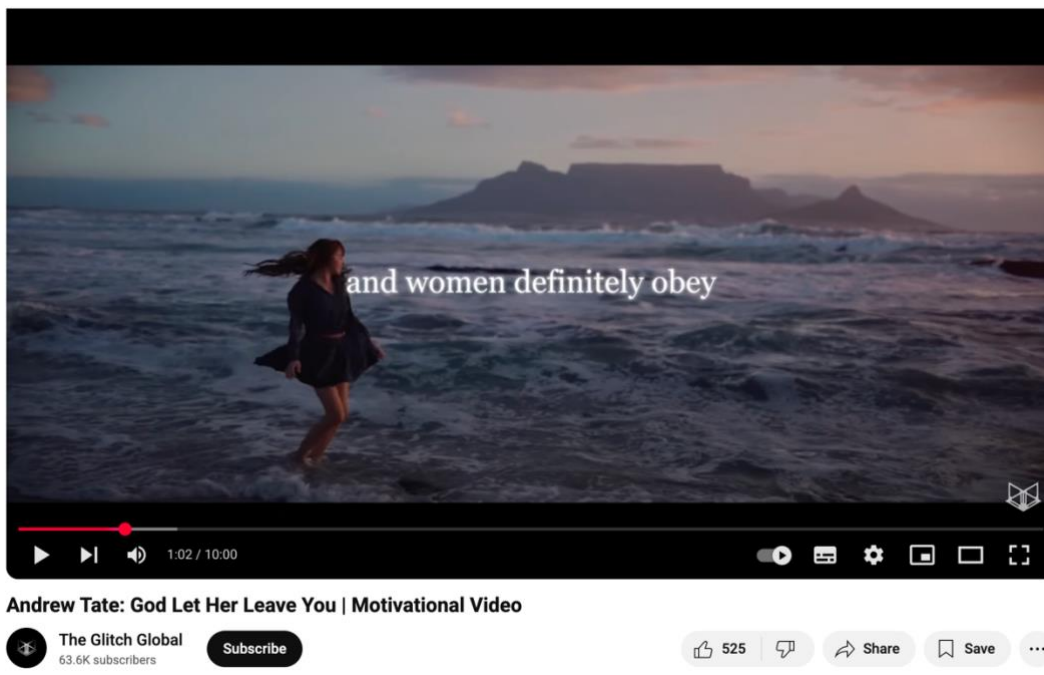
58 out of 100 most-viewed videos violate YouTube's policies on hate speech

Researchers identified 58 out of the 100 most-viewed videos featuring Tate promoting misogynist views that clearly violate YouTube's policies on hate speech.^x

YouTube's policies on hate speech state that they "don't allow content that promotes violence or hatred against individuals or groups based on [...] attributes" such as sex or gender, including slurs and stereotypes.^{xi} While the remaining 42 videos contained overt sexism, researchers assessed they were of the kind unlikely to violate YouTube's policies.

Examples of misogynist views promoted by Tate and breaking YouTube's policies on hate speech include:

- *"Women definitely obey, and they will clean your room, and they'll make you coffee, and they'll share you and they'll do anything you say."*^{xii}
- *"Nowadays it's gotten so fucked up – you got the men and the women, the husband and wife, all together on the same table. The men are trying to have a conversation, some dude's wife fucking pipes up."*^{xiii}
- *"You can't find a woman. You have to make a woman. You have to teach her and guide her. She has to learn from you. She has to grow from you."*^{xiv}
- *"Have a solid bottom b**** [...] if you have one girl who truly is out [...] and is on your side, and you can use her to control other girls, it's so much easier."*^{xv}



31 out of 100 videos violating YouTube's policies carry ads from big brands

Researchers identified ads for 31 out of 100 most-viewed videos, which promote misogyny violating YouTube's policies on hate speech, allowing the platform to profit from them.

YouTube's policies on monetization require that channels follow platform Community Guidelines, including policies on hate speech.^{xvi} However, researchers identified 31 videos carrying ads which contained misogynist content breaching these policies. In total, these videos amassed over 28 million views.

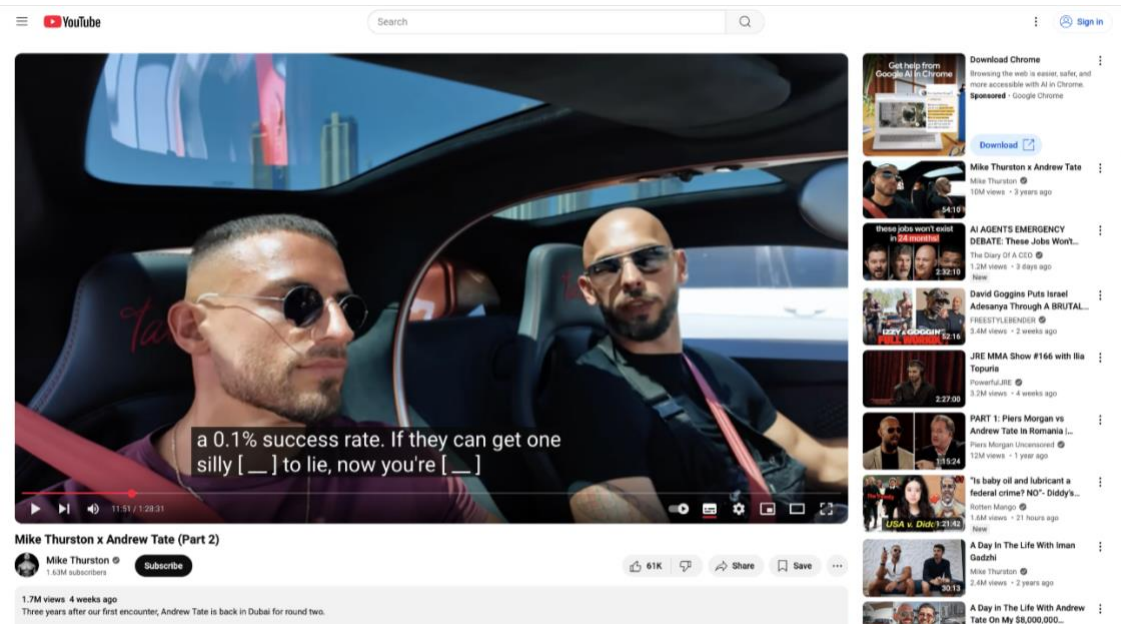
Researchers found both in-stream and in-feed ads from big brands, including Hyundai and Olay, served next to or on videos featuring Tate promoting misogynist claims. In-stream ads play before, during or after videos and can be skipped, while in-feed video ads appear as thumbnails next to video content.^{xvii}

Examples include:

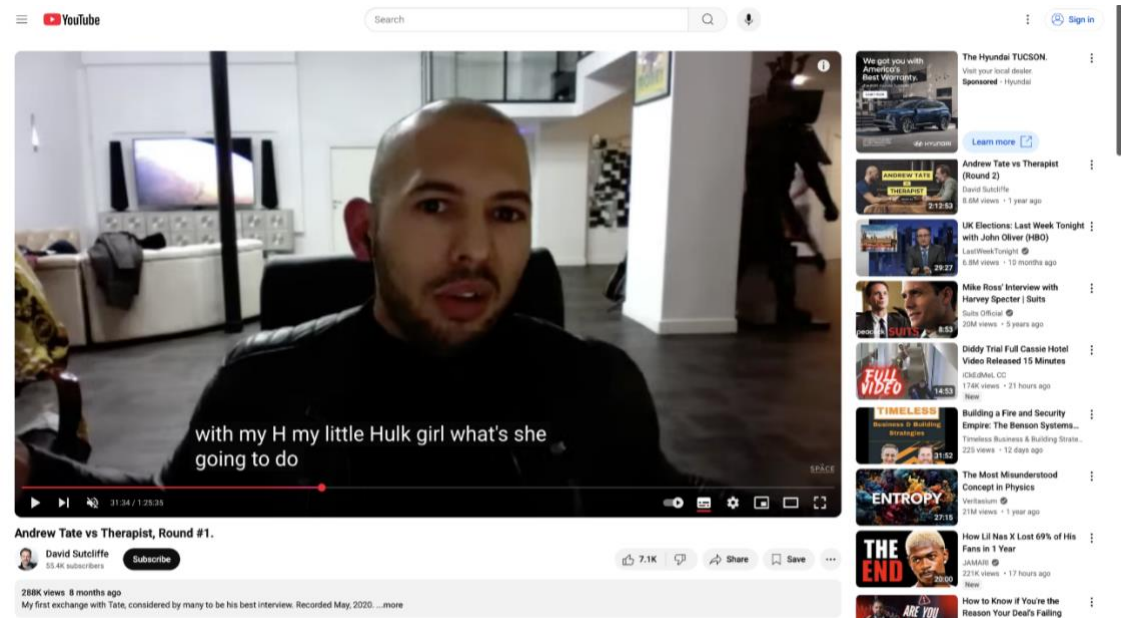
- An ad from Lavazza by a video featuring Tate saying: "Respect isn't something you beg for, it's something you become. You want her to submit – become someone she wants to follow. You want her loyalty – build a life she doesn't want to lose."^{xviii}

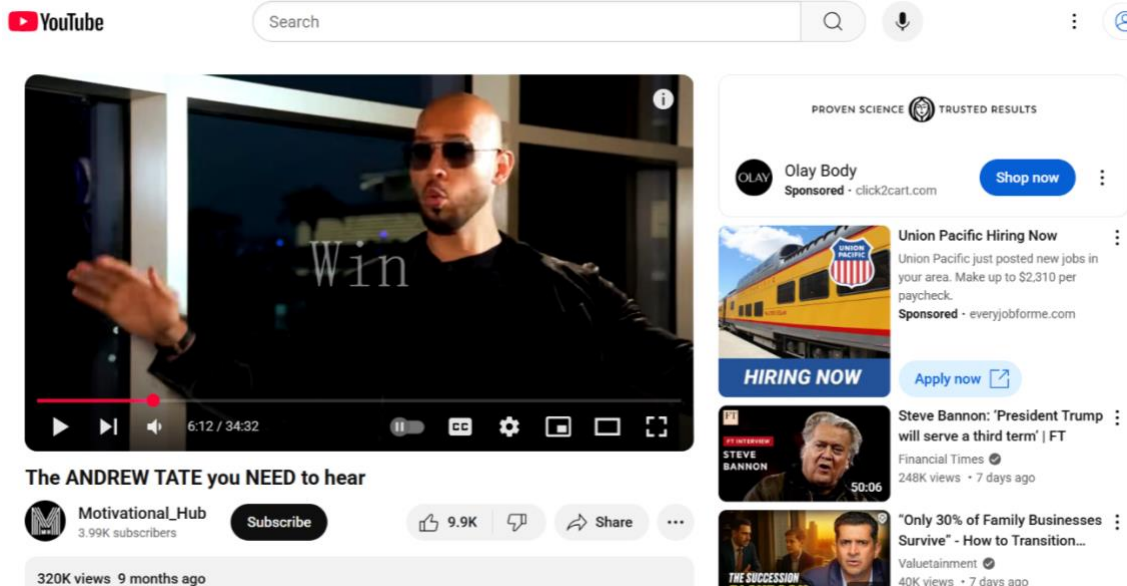
- An ad from Google placed by a video where Tate says: "You're telling me when you're famous and rich, they can't find some bitter ex-girlfriend full of fucking valium to tell a lie to wreck your life? 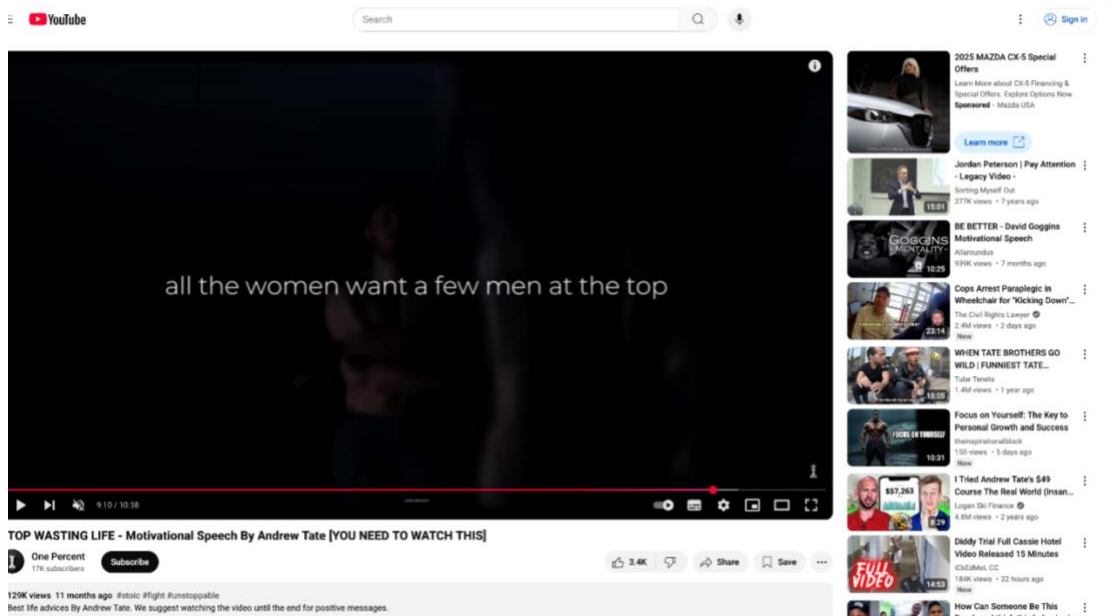
- An ad from Hyundai on a video where Tate says: "I don't see women as capable. It does not mean I hate them, I just don't see them as emotionally capable"^{xx}



- An ad from Olay on a video where Tate says: “you want that b****, you can have her. You can have anything you want on the planet. There's not a girl I look at that I want that I can't have, not one.”^{xxi}



- An ad from Mazda on a video where Tate says: “all the women want a few men at the top.”^{xxii}

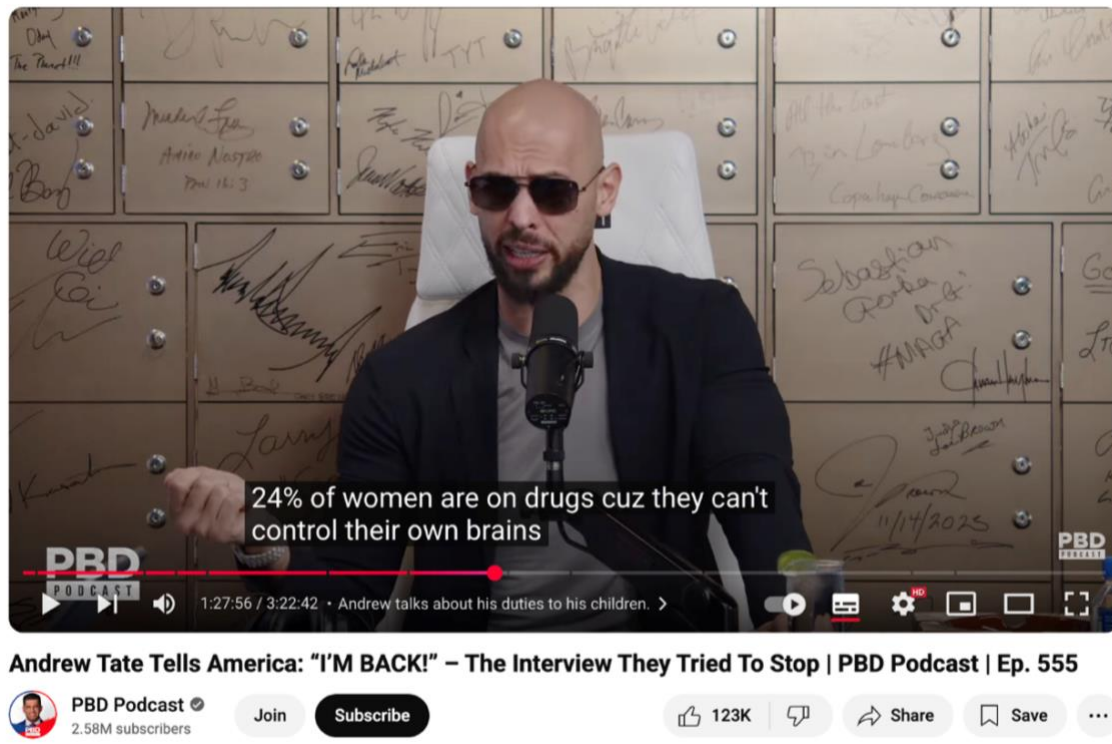


All 100 videos of Tate can be viewed by boys as young as 13 in the UK and US

Researchers found that all 100 most-viewed videos identified as featuring Andrew Tate's promotion of misogyny can be viewed by teen users on YouTube in the UK and US.

Researchers set up YouTube accounts for 13-year-old boys based in the UK, US, Ireland and Germany to test whether the videos could be viewed by teenagers in various jurisdictions. All 100 videos were visible to teenagers in both the UK and US. Researchers also confirmed that 98 videos were visible to teens in Ireland and Germany.^{xxiii}

This means that boys as young as 13 can watch videos of Tate promoting sexist falsehoods about women, including the following video in which he says: "What percentage of women are on mental health medication? What percentage of women are depressed? You think women don't lie? I would argue and I'm going to guess 17% to 24% of women are on drugs, because they can't control their own brains."^{xxiv}



A poll from YouGov found that over half of UK boys aged 6–15 have heard of Tate, while one in eight said they agreed with Tate's views on women.^{xxv} While the poll found that the respondents were more drawn to Tate's views on work, success and masculinity, analysis of YouTube videos in this dataset shows that YouTube is exposing boys to Tate's misogynist views amongst more seemingly benign content.^{xxvi}

97 out of 100 videos have auto-translated captions into multiple languages

Researchers found that 97 of the 100 most-viewed videos offer auto-translated captions, allowing Tate's misogynist content to be promoted to teen boys internationally.

Researchers used a VPN and changed the location settings of the sock puppet account to Germany, to test whether the 100 videos could be viewed with translated subtitles in countries where English is not the official language.

The study found that YouTube provides an auto translation of captions into German alongside other languages for 97 of the 100 videos, meaning that videos featuring Tate promoting misogyny can reach young boys worldwide.^{xxvii} While translations may not be fully accurate, researchers concluded that the captions captured Tate's messaging.

The following video shows German translated captions from a video in which Tate says, "Nowadays it's gotten so fucked up – you got the men and the women, the husband and wife, all together on the same table. The men are trying to have a conversation, some dude's wife fucking pipes up."^{xxviii}

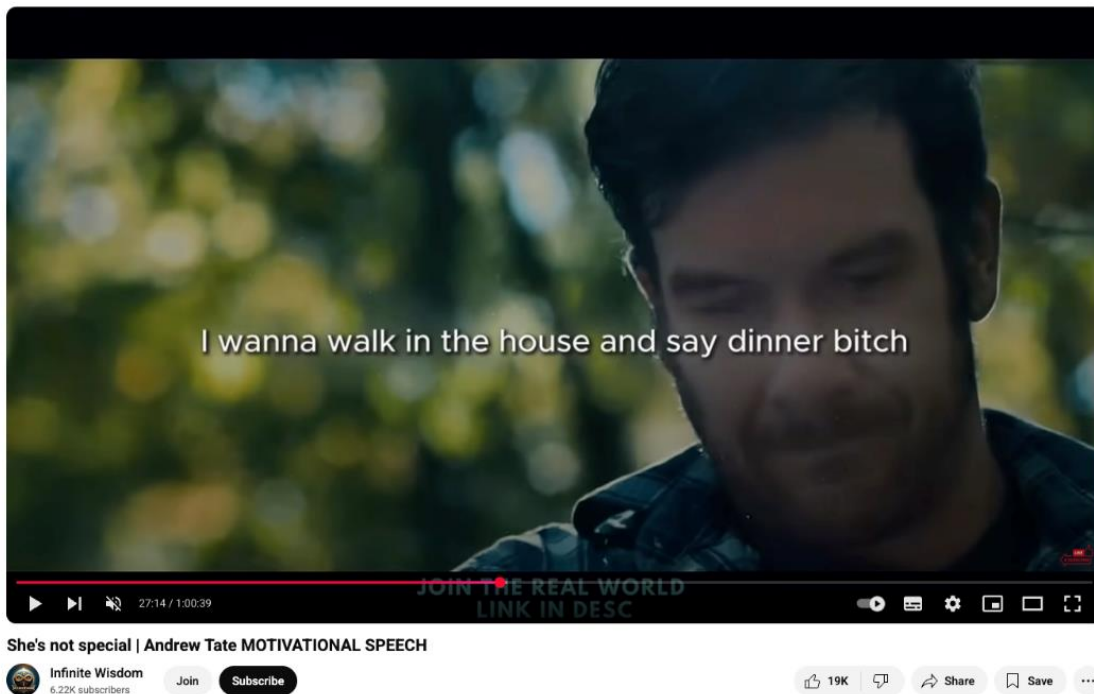


65 out of 100 videos of Tate promoting misogyny made and posted by ‘fan accounts’

Despite YouTube’s decision in 2022 to ban Tate after his content was found to violate its policies, researchers found he remains present on the platform through guest appearances on podcasts and videos edited and posted by ‘fan accounts’.^{xxix}

Researchers identified that 65 out of the 100 most-viewed videos promoting Tate and his misogynist views appear to be produced by ‘fan accounts’. These videos had received over 16.8 million views altogether at the time of the research. The remaining 35 videos consisted of clips and full-length podcast interviews featuring Tate.

Videos uploaded by fans often contain edited video or audio clips of Tate clipped from interviews, set against background music and stock images. Content is often uploaded by unofficial YouTube accounts with relatively small followings, and typically named self-help or Tate-related slogans, such as “Top G Mantra” and “Infinite Wisdom”.^{xxx}



These videos may be circulated by subscribers of Tate’s online course, “The Real World”, which promises to “support, educate, and guide” young men on their entrepreneurial journey.^{xxxi} Subscribers paying a monthly fee of \$49.99 are tasked with editing and sharing videos of Tate, maintaining his presence on social media despite bans.^{xxxii}

Once accounts have reached a substantial following, they are invited to post videos with an affiliate link to the “The Real World” course, from which they can receive a commission from those who sign up through it.^{xxxiii} But one former user revealed that, in reality, he spent up to 16 hours a day editing and publishing videos without making substantial money.^{xxxiv}

While it is unclear which fan accounts are subscribed to Tate’s online course, researchers were able to identify the same, typical characteristics across fan-made videos.

Methodology

Researchers used the YouTube API to search for videos posted between 1 May 2024 and 1 May 2025, using the search term “Andrew Tate” and ranking by views. This returned a set of 1,889 videos with view figures.

They then gathered transcripts for the videos using YouTube’s automated caption generator feature. Of the original set, 342 videos were excluded where captions had been disabled or if the video was not in English.

A keyword search was used to narrow the videos down to those likely to be relevant to the project, leaving 1,014. The keywords used are below.

'wom(ela)n', 'female', 'girl', 'her(\b|s)', 'she(\b|s)', 'femin', 'hooker', 'prostitute', 'porn', 'sex', 'boob', 'bikini', 'bra(\b|s)', 'kitchen', 'sandwich', 'wi(fl|v)e', 'tran(ny|n|l|s|sexual|gender)', 'skirt(\b|s)', 'machete', 'virgin'

Researchers went through the list 1,014 videos by descending order of views to identify the most-viewed 100 videos containing misogyny, which can be defined as “the belief that women are a lesser gender than men and should always remain at a lower status than men”.^{xxxv} This includes content which dehumanizes and subjugates women, including the use of slurs, or promotes harm against them. All videos were available on YouTube at the time of our US and UK analysis on 27 May 2025, but two had been removed by the time of our Germany and Ireland analysis carried out from 10–11 June 2025.

Videos criticizing Tate and news coverage were excluded, leaving a final set of 100 videos in which Tate himself appears and expresses misogynist views. For each video featuring Tate expressing misogynist views, an example along with the timestamp was recorded.

Each example was then cross-referenced with YouTube’s policies on hate speech and any policy violations were recorded. To quality check the set, a second researcher reviewed the labels of the first. Where there was disagreement a team of three researchers discussed the video to reach a consensus agreement.

Each video marked as containing misogyny following quality checks was opened and checked for adverts. Videos containing in-stream adverts or sidebar adverts were counted.

To check if videos could be viewed by young users, we created accounts with their age set to 13 years old during the account set-up process. Accounts had their gender set to

male, with locations set to the United Kingdom, the United States, Ireland and Germany. We set up the accounts to maintain a clear search and watch history. Using these accounts and a VPN, we clicked through each of the 100 videos and recorded if they were accessible.
